<sup>1</sup> Tuition fees are non-refundable except at the school's sole discretion. A discount of 1% is applicable to the tuition fees when the full year's fees are paid in advance. This discount does not apply to tuition paid on a term-by-term basis.

£15 is added to the autumn term's tuition fees only to cover the cost of the Yearbook.

<sup>2</sup> Payable once on entry and non-refundable in all cases. The Admission Fee is not charged for students joining the school at the 6th Form level.

<sup>3</sup> Payable prior to testing (with the exception of Foundation 1) and non-refundable in all cases.

<sup>4</sup> Refundable deposit – this is applied to new entrants to Foundation 1 and above. The deposit is refunded on the day the child leaves BISC.

For the first child of families new to BISC: £2,000 Sterling or the equivalent in any currency including Egyptian pounds.

For the second and subsequent children of families new to BISC: £1,000 Sterling or equivalent in Egyptian Pounds.

For the siblings of children already at BISC: £1,000 Sterling or the equivalent in Egyptian Pounds.

The refundable deposit is payable in full within the child's first academic year. The deposit may be paid in any currency including Egyptian Pounds. You will be refunded in the same currency and for exactly the same amount which you paid. If you wish you may pay in instalments of £500 sterling or the equivalent in another currency. At least one instalment per child must be paid each term, beginning with the first term.
